Students at Devonshire Elementary have a serious lack of funds for most households and many of the students are given what they need for the school day from the school itself. The school provides free uniform items to those students who cannot afford to purchase their own. Having the appropriate clothing to wear to school is important for students to feel at ease/at home in the school and put them in the right frame of mind for learning. The students at South Mecklenburg's NHS chapter want to support this positive feeling by helping the school store keep these items available at no charge for students in need.

All donated items need to be new, with tags attached and need to be brought to A204 for collection.

Students will have to sign acknowledging the hours that they earn for this project. If you want to drop off items before school you must contact Mrs. Duke first (<u>Kimberly.duke@cms.k12.nc.us</u>) so that she can unlock the door and this may only be done from 6:50-7:00. You can also drop off items right after school. <u>Do not try to drop off items between classes or during lunches.</u>

Shirt color: Navy Blue or White

Shirt style: Polo-style shirt with collar (long or short sleeved), turtleneck, Peter Pan collar blouse

Pants/Shorts/Skorts/Jumpers color: Khaki or Navy Blue
